



## Busselton Runners Club Athlete Grant

### Terms and Conditions

1. The Busselton Runners Club (BRC) Committee may accept or reject any application for a grant in its absolute discretion.
2. If the BRC decides to make a grant (Grant) to the applicant the Grant will be made subject to these terms and conditions.
3. The BRC will make a one off payment to the successful applicant (Applicant).
4. The Applicant must:
  - a. meet all eligibility criteria (as set out in the application form) for application and receipt of the Grant and must promptly notify the BRC if the Applicant no longer fulfils all of those eligibility criteria;
  - b. only use the Grant towards the cost of travel, accommodation, entry fees, uniforms or equipment for the nominated sporting event;
  - c. keep records detailing the use and expenditure of the Grant, and allow the BRC or its authorised representatives to assess these records for the purpose of auditing the use of the Grant;
  - d. when attending the nominated sporting event, conduct him or herself in a dignified and reputable manner including compliance with relevant Anti Doping Policies and Codes of Behaviour related to the event.
7. Without limitation to any other rights of the BRC, if the BRC reasonably believes, at any time following the award of the Grant, that the Applicant:
  - a. has provided false or misleading information in the application;
  - b. has not attended, or will not attend the nominated sporting event; or
  - c. has otherwise breached any of its obligations set out in these terms and conditions, then the BRC may by written notice require the Applicant to repay the BRC, at the BRC's absolute discretion, all or part of the Grant. The amount notified must be repaid within 30 days of any such notice.
8. Before or after the award of the Grant, the Applicant must, if requested by the BRC, cooperate with the BRC in relation to publicity initiatives regarding the grant programme.
9. Details of successful Applicants (including: biographical information such as their name, home state, sport, and any photo of them produced in connection with the programme; the value of the Grant awarded; and a brief description of the purpose for the Grant) may be released by the BRC to the public and the media and may be placed on the BRC website, including for promotional purposes.
